The numbers in the right hand margin of the detailed interpretation refer to similar numbers on the attached mosaic. All scales and measurements are approximate, and all directions are based on a 16-point compass. SUMMARY A first class military airdreme is located two and one-half (2) miles NW of the City of Taichu. This airdrome has complete facilities for maintenance and repair of aircraft. The City, covering an area of approximately five (5) square miles, is located approximately ten and one-half (102) miles east of the coast, and slightly N of the middle of the Island of Formosa. Taichu is the center of a considerable amount of military activity evidenced by numerous military camps and barracks. The following is a summary of the installations located and described in the detailed interpretation. I. AIRDROMES: A. Six Hangars. B. Several administration buildings, shops, barracks, and warehouses. C. Seventy (70) revetments, a firing butt, and a beacon light. D. Several M/G and light A/A positions. II. MILITARY CAMPS AND BARRACKS: One (1) large military camp and training area. B. Six (6) small and medium-sized military camps and barracks. III. WAREHOUSE AND STORAGE AREAS: Seven (7) warehouse areas in conjunction with RR yards. Five (5) warehouse areas dispersed throughout the town and within industrial areas. Two (2) revetted ammunition storage buildings. IV. DEFENSES: Three (3) light AA positions. Many M/G positions. TRANSPORTATION: One (1) RR yard. One (1) RR line. Three (3) paved highways. DETAILED INTERPRETATION

Installation No. (See Attached Mosaic.)

I. TAICHU AIRDROME:

Location: A large first class military airdrome is located two and one-half (2) miles NW of the City of Taichu. The airdrome is approximately eight (8) miles inland from the west coast of Formosa.

Landmarks: The Taito River and a conspicuous pattern of gullies and intermittent streams approximately six (6) miles to the west and SW offer good landmarks. The presence of Toyohara Airdrome just four and one-half (42) miles to the north also serves to locate Taichu A/D.

Size, Shape & Condition: The airdrome is rectangular in shape, the dimensions being 4250 k 3800'. The entire landing area is graded, surfaced with sod or gravel, drained, and usable practically all of the time.

Runways and Taxi Strips: There are no definite runways, but the field is suitable for landing in any direction. A circular taxiway, 3150' in diameter, is being constructed around the NW corner of the field for use as a dispersal area. A newly constructed taxistrip, 1620 ft. long, runs from the NW corner of the field MSW to the circular taxiway.

Expansion Possibilities: The airdrome could be readily expanded in any direction.

Obstructions: There are no obstructions in any direction except the buildings at the SE corner of the A/D.

Hangars: Six (6) hangars, 160' x 145', are located at the SE corner of the field. Paved service aprons, 350' x 90', lead to four (4) of the hangars. One (1) hangar has a paved apron, 150' x 90'.

Shops, Barracks, and Other Buildings: A large administration area, 2200' x 1250', is located at the SE corner of the field, adjacent to the hangars, and consists of the following:

Mosaic.) One (1) probable operations building, 210' x 60'. Two (2) barracks-type buildings, 2101 x 701. One (1) barracks-type building, 270' x 70'. Four (4) administration—type buildings, 150' x 50'.

One (1) "H"—shaped building, the two wings of which are 170' x 30' and 170' x 55'. One (1) storage-type building, 285' x 60'. Four (4) storage-type buildings averaging 130' x 40'. One (1) shop-type building, 165: x 501. Five (5) shop-type buildings, 100' x 55'. One (1) partly camouflaged probable supply building, 140' x 201. One (1) partly camouflaged probable supply building, 701 Approximately thirty (30) small miscellaneous buildings. One (1) probable garage, 140' x 30'. Two (2) water towers. Aircraft Dispersal: Seventy-three (73) revetments for small _____ 5 aircraft are dispersed about the A/D as follows: Twelve (12) revetments, 50' in width, are served by the circular taxiway at MW corner of field. This is shown on M 13/7 C. Fifteen (15) revetments (in groups of three), 50' in width twelve of which are covered, are located in SW corner of field. Eighteen (18) revetments (in groups of three), 50' in width, of which twelve (12) are covered, are located in ME corner of field. Fifteen (15) revetments (in groups of three), 50' in width, of which twelve (12) are covered, are located in the NW corner of the field. Thirteen (13) revetments, 45! in width, are located along the west side of field. Miscellaneous Airdrome Installations: A firing butt, 140' --- 6 in width, with a paved apron 200 ft. away, is located adjacent to the northernmost hangar. Three (3) storage-type revetments, 60' x 40', probably munitions storage, are located at the NE corner of the field. One (1) beacon light is visible in the center of the admin- --- 8 istration area. An unidentified group of buildings, all connected by covered walkways, is located 1400' east of the administration area and consists of the following: Two (2) wings, 180' x 20'. Two (2) wings averaging 50' x 30'. A center section covering an area of approximately 1001 x 901.

A building, 150' x 75', is under construction one and one-fourth (11) miles NNE of the A/D. This building may probably be used in connection with the airdrome.

Defenses: Many M/G positions are located in the hangar and administration areas at the SE side of the field.

One (1) probable light A/A position is located at the SW corner of the field.

Two (2) M/G positions are located in SW corner of field.

Three (3) M/G positions are located in NE corner of field.

Numerous fox holes and slit trenches are visible throughout the A/D and particularly in the hanger and administration areas.

II. MILITARY CAMPS & BARRACKS:

A military school covering an area 1130' x 1050' is located 1-3/4 miles SW of RR station (See Installation #31), and consists of the following facilities:

Five (5) barracks-type buildings, 570 x 40'. Two (2) barracks-type buildings, 315 x 201. One (1) barracks-type building, 300' x 40'.

Two (2) administration-type buildings averaging 110' x 60'.

Nine (9) small miscellaneous buildings.

A barracks area, approximately 1150' x 850', is under construc- ---- 12 tion one (1) mile SSW of RR station. The facilities here include the following:

Two heavily revetted munitions storage buildings, 35' x 30', and 65' x 20', are located in the NE corner of the above military area.

A probable officers quarters area consisting of twenty-five (25) buildings, 30' x 40', is located at NE corner of the above military area.

Two (2) schools or permanent garrisons are located adjacent to _____ 16 each other, 4500! N of the RR station. The combined facilities of the two schools are as follows:

One (1) building, 100; x 55; Ten (10) small miscellaneous buildings. A small school or military camp covering an area 1000' x 900' is located 3300' S of the A/D, and contains the following: One (1) large dormitory or administration building, 450' x 50'. One (1) building, 300! x 40!. Three (3) buildings, 180' x 80'. Six (6) buildings averaging 210' x 35'. III: WAREHOUSE AND STORAGE AREAS: A warehouse area, 580' x 210', is located 1.1 miles WSW of RR station, and consists of the following: Four (4) camouflaged warehouse buildings, 150' x 55'. One (1) camouflaged warehouse building, 155' x 55'. One (1) warehouse building, 155' x 45'. A storage area is located 2700' ENE of RR station, and corsists of several adjacent warehouses covering an area 600' x 35'. Quantities of loose stores are visible here. A small probable storage area is located approximately 1-3/4 miles SW of the RR station and near the military camp (described in Paragraph #32). The following installations are located in this area: One (1) camouflaged building, 185' x 55'. One (1) building, 110' x 40'. Three (3) small buildings averaging 451 x 251 A barracks or storage area covering a space 1400' x 700' is being--- 24 built approximately 1-3/4 miles NNV of the RR station. The facilities here include the following: Three (3) buildings, 285 x 30'. One (1) building, 355° x 30'. One (1) building, 145° x 30'.

Six (6) miscellaneous buildings.

A warehouse area is located at the east end of the small loading ---- 25 yard within the alcohol plant and 2800' east of the RR station. The facilities here include:

Five (5) storage buildings averaging 70' x 40'. One (1) storage building, 115' x 70'.

A warehouse area is located at the south side of the alcohol plant ———— 26 (Installation #35) which is located just east of the RR yards. The following buildings are visible here:

Five (5) warehouses, 215' x 30'.

One (1) warehouse, 170' x 90'.

One (1) warehouse, 110' x 90'.

One (1) warehouse, 115' x 70'.

Ten (10) warehouses, 70' x 40'.

IV. DEFENSES:

The only defenses visible in the City are those located in the military area NE of the RR yards and described under Installation #13.

V. TRANSPORTATION:

Highways: A good highway enters the City of Taichu from the NE, --- 27 passes through the center of the City and leaves in a SW direction.

A paved highway which passes the NE corner of the airdrome enters ———— 28 the City from the NNV.

A new highway which enters the City from the NW is under construc- ---- 29 tion. A strip, 1550' long, at the edge of the City has not yet been completed.

The City is also served by several other roads which lead out from it in all directions.

The RR yard, running ENE-WSW, is located just SE of the center of ---- 31 town. The yard is 1450' long, and at its widest point has fifteen (15) tracks. A narrow guage single track leads from the ENE choke point of RR yard in an ESE direction beyond the photo coverage. A spur swings north from this track to serve the alcohol plant. A 55' turntable is located at the ENE end of the main RR yard.

The passenger RR station, 200' x 60', is located near the center, and on the N side of the RR yard.

At the MSW end of the yard is a series of warehouses covering an area 450' x 50'.

At the ENE end of the yard is a series of warehouses covering anarea, 480' x 50'.

At the MNW side of RR yard is a series of warehouses covering an area 450' x 50'. One (1) warehouse—type building, 190' x 30', is located on NNW side of RR yard.

On the 12 January 1944 coverage approximately 30 RR cars were visible here.

Canals: A controlled stream channel runs through the NW section ---- 32 of the City in a NE-SW direction. No boat activity is visible.

A controlled stream channel runs through the center of the City in ---- 33 a general NE-SW direction. No boat activity is visible.

VI. INDUSTRY:

A brick plant is located 4500' NE of the RR station. The plant is ____ 34 approximately 1000' x 500: and consists of the following:

Three (3) large kilns, 150' x 45'. Eight (8) drying sheds, 170' x 15'. Two (2) drying sheds, 250' x 15'. One (1) drying shed, 140' x 15'. Four (4) drying sheds, 100' x 15'.

A tall stack is located in the center of the area.

Raw materials are brought into the west side of the plant. Four (4) buildings averaging 130 x 30 are located in this area.

Ten (10) receiving warehouses averaging 70' x 40'.

One (1) receiving warehouse 115 x 70'.

One (1) receiving and unloading building, 230' x 55'.

One (1) crusher building, 100' x 100'.

One (1) cooking building, 110' x 80', with adjacent stack.
One (1) distillation building with an area of 19,000 sq. ft.

One (1) warehouse for finished products, 170' x 90'.
One (1) warehouse for finished products, 110' x 90'.
Five (5) warehouses for finished products, 125' x 30'.

One (I.) administration building, 180! x 55!.

Three (3) storage tanks approximately 50' in diameter.

Approximately 130' small narrow guage RR cars are present
in the coverage of 12 January 1944.

A small unidentified industry is located 1-1/3 miles NW of RR yard. 37 The following buildings are visible here.

One (1) building, 110' x 80'.

One (1) building, 150! x 60!.

One (1) building, 110' x 60'.

One (1) building, 70' x 60'.

Fourteen (14) miscellaneous buildings.

A large unidentified light industrial plant, covering an area 900' ---- 38 x 700', is located 1700' SW of the NR station. The following installations are visible here:

One (1) large factory-type building, 200' x 100'.

One (1) "L"-shaped factory-type building with approximately 23,500 sq. ft, of floor space.

Two (2) factory-type buildings, 1851 x 40'.

Two (2) factory-type buildings averaging 110' x 40'.

Three (3) shop-type buildings averaging 120' x 115'.

Two (2) shop-type buildings averaging 110' x 70'.

A power unit, 60% x 35%, with tall stack adjacent.

A transformer station is located $l_{\overline{4}}^{1}$ miles NNE of the RR station. —— 42 The transformer station covers an area of 280' x 200' and included within this area are four (4) buildings ranging in size from 40' x 40' to 25' x 25'.

A transmission line runs SSE from the transformer station.
