The Tenth International Conference on ASIA GIS (ASIA GIS 2014) is held at Vayupak Convention Center, Bangkok, Thailand, during February 9 - 11, 2014. Asia GIS is a biannual program organized by Asia Geographic Information System Association (AGISA) for GIS academics and professionals in the Asia-Pacific region. ASIA GIS was first held in Hong Kong (1994) and subsequently in Bangkok (1996), Taipei (1998), Tokyo (2000), Wuhan (2003), and Johor, Malaysia (2006), Korea (2008), Taiwan (2010), Mongolia (2012) .
